Good Food Box Delivery Drivers help make healthy, affordable food accessible to everyone in our community. By delivering food boxes to participants' homes or community pick-up sites, volunteers play a vital role in reducing barriers to healthy eating and supporting community connection.

Location: 21 Angeline St N Lindsay pick up, drop off to individual homes within Lindsay

Schedule: Third Tuesday of the month between 1:30 pm – 4 pm

Key Responsibilities

- Pick up Good Food Boxes from the designated site at the scheduled time.
- Deliver boxes safely to participants' homes.
- Provide friendly, respectful interaction with participants at each delivery.
- Maintain confidentiality and handle deliveries with care and professionalism.
- Collect payment from participants, if required.
- Notify staff if a delivery cannot be completed or if any concerns arise.
- Return delivery materials (e.g., boxes, payment, etc.) as directed.

Time Commitment

1 – 2 hours, the third Tuesday of the month, each month, between 1:30 – 4 pm

Support Provided

Orientation and ongoing support are provided by wellness staff. Volunteers receive information about routes, safety, and communication procedures before each delivery day. Community Care will compensate your mileage at a rate of \$0.47 cents per kilometer.
