

Volunteer Opportunity Pickleball Program Volunteer – Bobcaygeon

Pickleball Volunteers help ensure that Community Care’s Bobcaygeon Pickleball program runs smoothly and provides a welcoming, safe, and fun environment for participants. Volunteers greet players, help with program set up and take down, organize sign-in and attendance, and provide general information to participants. This role supports both new and experienced players to enjoy the game and build community connections.

Location: Bobcaygeon Curling Club or Bobcaygeon Public School

Schedule: Monday and Wednesday evenings from 7 pm – 9 pm, Friday mornings in the summer

Key Responsibilities

- Welcome participants as they arrive and create an inclusive, friendly atmosphere.
- Take attendance and assist with participant sign-in.
- Help set up and take down nets, equipment, and other materials before and after games.
- Support fair play by helping to rotate players on and off courts when needed.
- Report any concerns, incidents, or participant feedback to program staff.

Time Commitment

One to two shifts per week (approx. 2 hours each), with flexibility.

Support Provided

Pickleball Volunteers receive orientation, role-specific training, and ongoing support from program staff. Equipment and resources are provided.
